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



The Brief

MallTopia was looking to develop a new location-based experience for a flagship shopping mall location in Springfield, Virginia, which could become a model for the transformation of larger sites across the US.

We were asked to propose a unique new entertainment concept for the existing space (100,000 sq ft across 2 floors), with consideration to existing entertainment, retail, and food & beverage offerings in the area.

- 3. Whirlington

Concept Design




Schematic Design








Bird's eye view by Sven Nibbeling & Zoe Macarewa; Logo and entrance illustration by Zoe Macarewa






Arabian Nights Inspired Attractions


The Deep End
